Why not come to our free entry 2020 Heritage Open Day at Forge Mill Needle Museum and Bordesley Abbey Visitor Centre, which is organised and run by the volunteers at the museum.

Among the activities are:

- Royal Enfield Motor bikes from members of the regional owners Club
- Working scale model boats from the Little Radford Model Boat Club
- An exhibition of local art by members of the Redditch Art Circle.
- Live music from Indigo Arts, a Redditch charity supporting young people.
- A poster exhibition from the Redditch Local History Society and the Royal Enfield owners club, entitled 'The Royal Enfield in WW2'.
- Free entry to the museum and, for our visitors, the only existing water powered scouring mill will be operating on the day.
- Free scheduled tours by our experienced volunteer guides of the Needle Museum and the Bordesley Abbey ruins.
- Free entry to the current exhibition in the Museum gallery 'Sacred Spaces' an exhibition by the Stitch in the Middle Group.
- Refreshments at the volunteer run Coffee Bar.

The Event runs from 11.00 am to 4.00 pm.
